#### Day 1: Windhoek, Namibia

Arrival and airport transfer to your lodge, the rest of the day is at leisure to explore your surroundings. Terra Africa Guest House or similar

#### Days 2 - 3: Sossusvlei, Namibia

Sossusvlei and Namib Naukluft National Park form part of the Namib Desert. Visit the world's tallest sand dunes, Dead Vlei and stop at Sesriem Canyon. Agama River Camp or similar

#### Days 4 - 5: Swakopmund, Namibia

Stop at Walvis Bay on your way to Swakopmund. Explore the area with optional activities such as scenic flights, sandboarding or the living desert tour. Alte Brücke Resort or similar

#### Day 6: Etosha National Park, Namibia

Drive to Etosha National Park, where your afternoon is at leisure at the lodge. Toshari Lodge

#### Days 7 - 8: Etosha National Park, Namibia

Full-day game drives through Etosha National Park. The park is home to hundreds of species of mammals, birds and reptiles, including several threatened and endangered species such as the black rhino. Namutoni Camp or similar

#### Day 9: Rundu, Namibia

Visit the Mbunza Living Museum. The main focus of the museum is to provide visitors with a detailed and authentic insight into the traditional, pre-colonial culture. Kaisosi River Lodge or similar

#### Days 10 - 11: Caprivi, Namibia


Enjoy a relaxing sunset cruise in the Caprivi Strip. The next day we explore Mahango Game Reserve, a conservation success story, on a game drive. Nunda River Lodge or similar

#### Day 12: Maun, Botswana

Late afternoon arrival in Maun, the gateway to the Okavango Delta. Thamalakane River Lodge

#### Day 13: Okavango Delta & Greater Moremi, Botswana

Experience a traditional Okavango Delta Mokoro excursion in the morning. Enjoy an evening/







night game drive after dinner. Bedouin Bush Camp or similar

#### Day 14: Greater Moremi, Botswana

Game viewing in the Moremi Area in search of the plentiful species of animal that roam the bushveld. **Bedouin Bush Camp or similar** 

#### Day 15: Makgadikgadi Pans, Botswana

Visit the Nata Bird Sanctuary a community managed reserve with 165 different species of bird and a fantastic breeding ground for flamingos. *Nata Lodge or similar* 

#### Days 16 - 17: Chobe National Park, Botswana

Chobe National Park is known for large herds of elephant and buffalo. We explore the area on a morning game drive and afternoon sunset cruise. Chobe Safari Lodge or similar

#### Days 18 - 19: Hwange National Park, Zimbabwe

Hwange National Park is Zimbabwe's largest national park. Optional activities such as game walks or community upliftment experiences are available. We spend time game-viewing in search for elephant herds, lion and rare African wild dog. Sable Sands or similar

#### Day 20: Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe

Experience a guided tour of the Victoria Falls and an intimate sunset cruise on the legendary Zambezi River. *Ilala Lodge or similar* 

#### Day 21: Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe

Airport transfer after breakfast, tour ends.


