



Desert Dune Safari

NAMIBIA

13 NIGHTS / 14 DAYS

This safari takes you through some of the most remote areas on this planet, beginning at the dunes of Sossusvlei and exploring the marine life off Swakopmund. We then discover the dramatic and secluded coastline of the Skeleton Coast and the desolate landscape of Namibia's starkly beautiful north-west where the last free-roaming black rhino rove. We end in the wildlife-rich Etosha National Park.

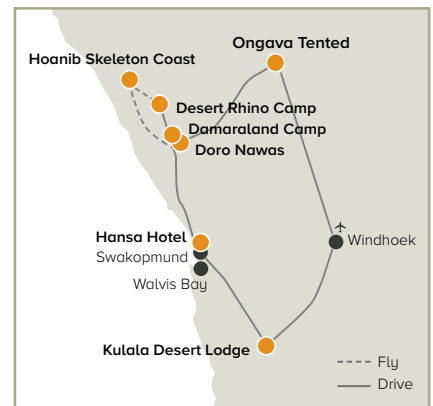
BRIEF ITINERARY:

- Days 1 – 2: Kulala Desert Lodge, Kulala Wilderness Reserve, Sossusvlei
- Days 3 – 4: Hansa Hotel, Swakopmund
- Day 5: Damaraland Camp, Damaraland
- Days 6 – 7: Desert Rhino Camp, Palmwag Concession
- Days 8 – 10: Hoanib Skeleton Coast Camp, Palmwag Concession
- Days 11 – 13: Ongava Tented Camp, Ongava Game Reserve, outside Etosha National Park
- Day 14: Return to Windhoek

Suggested extension: Visit Serra Cafema or Etosha National Park.
