Day 1: Arusha, Tanzania

Welcome at the airport and transfer to your hotel; the rest of the day is at leisure to relax or participate in optional activities. *Moivaro Coffee Plantation or similar*

Day 2: Tarangire, Tanzania

We travel to Tarangire National Park a (not so) little gem with big numbers of wildlife and more breeding species of birds than anywhere else in the world. *Rift Valley Photographic Lodge or similar*

Day 3: Lake Manyara, Tanzania

Full-day game drive in Lake Manyara National Park in search of the many species of bird and wildlife that frequent the area. *Rift Valley Photographic Lodge or similar*

Day 4: Ngorongoro and Serengeti, Tanzania

Early departure for a game drive in the world famous Ngorongoro Crater, after which we head off to the Serengeti through the endless plains of the southern section. *Kisura Kenzan Tented Camp or similar*

Day 5: Serengeti, Tanzania

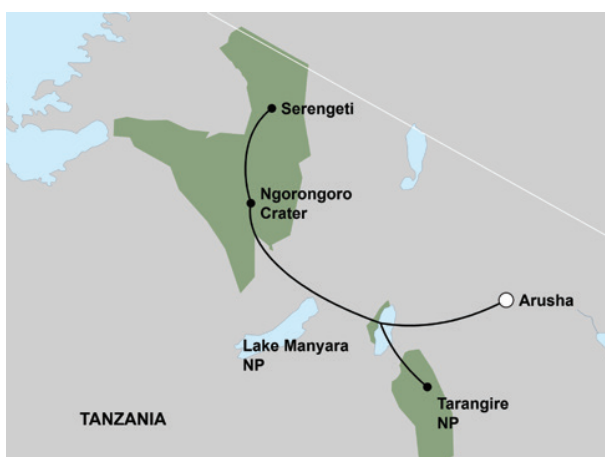
Full-day game drive spent exploring the Serengeti where you might be lucky enough to spot the famous wildebeest migration. *Kisura Kenzan Tented Camp or similar*

Day 6: Serengeti to Manyara, Tanzania

Morning game drive en route to Ngorongoro. Visit Olduvai Gorge en route which is one of the most important paleoanthropological sites in the world, before heading to the Manyara area. *Rift Valley Photographic Lodge or similar*

Day 7: Manyara to Arusha, Tanzania

After breakfast we explore the colourful town of Mto-wa-Mbu for last minute pictures and curio shopping. We then head off to Arusha, where the tour ends.
