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Day 1-2: Camping at Chobe River front within the Chobe National Park

Welcome at Kasane Airport. A snack pack before you depart on an afternoon boat cruise on the Chobe River. Following the boat cruise we leave Kasane and start our journey driving at game drive pace and keeping an eye out for wildlife and birds. We spend the first two nights camping in a pristine bush campsite near the Chobe River, exploring the river banks and surrounding floodplains on game drives.

Day 3-5: Camping at Savute within the Chobe National Park

We head further south within Chobe National Park, were we spend the following three nights camping at a pristine bush campsite in the Savute region and exploring the dry landscape on game drives.

Day 6-8: Camping in the Khwai Area of Moremi Game Reserve

We spend the next three nights camping at a campsite in the Khwai area, exploring the Khwai floodplains on game drives. You will also experience a 2½-hour mokoro trip, discovering channels and lagoons at a relaxed pace in a traditional dug-out canoe.

Day 9-10: Camping in the Xakanaxa/ 3rd Bridge Area of the Moremi Game Reserve & Okavango Delta

Spending our last two nights camping in the Xakanaxa/Third Bridge area, we explore the surrounding wilderness on game drives during the day. The Moremi Game Reserve protects around a third of the entire Okavango Delta ecosystem – some 5 000km2 (1 930 square miles).

Day 11: Safari ends in Maun

A short game drive and your guide will drop you at a bush airstrip to meet your pilot for your stunning light aircraft scenic flight over the Okavango Delta and Chief's Island back to Maun. This flight gives you a fish eagle's eye view of this amazing ecosystem. You will arrive in Maun around noon in time for your international flight.

The magic of a mobile camp becomes apparent as the sun sets and you enjoy drinks around the fire before a startit dinner and a great night's rest after falling asleep to the sounds of the African bush
