Day 1: Entebbe

Meet and greet at Airport and then transfer to your hotel. *2 Friends Beach Hotel or similar*

Day 2: Entebbe to Murchison Falls, Uganda

Depart to Murchison Falls. Visit the Ziwa Rhino and Wildlife Ranch, the home of the only wild rhinos in Uganda. *Paraa Safari Lodge or similar*

Day 3: Murchison Falls, Uganda

Morning game drive followed by a boat trip to view the Murchison Falls, while on board enjoy a cheese and wine tasting, game viewing the wild on the banks of the river. *Paraa Safari Lodge or similar*

Day 4: Murchison Falls to Hoima, Uganda

Trek man's closest genetic relative, the cheeky chimpanzee on a trekking excursion in the Budongo Forest. In the afternoon transfer to Hoima. *Hoima Cultural Lodge.*

Day 5: Hoima to Kibale, Uganda

Morning transfer to Kibale region. Afternoon guided walk through the Bigodi swamps, a jungle filled with monkeys and interesting birdlife. *Primate Lodge or similar*

Day 6: Kibale, Uganda

Beautiful morning drive through the dramatic landscape of the Crater Lakes. Transfer to Queen Elizabeth National Park. *Park View Safari Lodge or similar*

Day 7: Queen Elizabeth National Park, Uganda

Another opportunity to observe chimpanzees on a morning chimp trek in Kalinzu forest. Afternoon boat excursion on the Kazinga Channel which has the world's largest concentration of hippos and Nile crocodiles. *Park View Safari Lodge or similar*

Day 8: Queen Elizabeth National Park to Bwindi, Uganda

Drive to Bwindi Impenetrable Forest National Park. Afternoon at leisure. *Mahogany Lodge or similar*

Day 9: Bwindi, Uganda

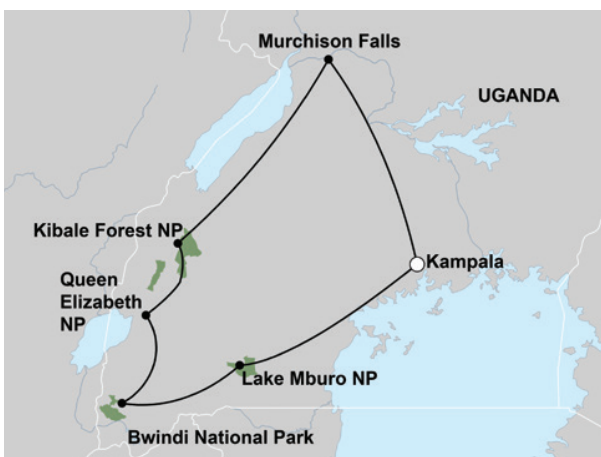
Today is the day for gorilla trekking! The trekking can be anything from 2 to 8 hours or longer depending on the location of the gorillas on the day, guests spend an hour with the gorillas but the memories last a lifetime. *Mahogany Lodge or similar*

Day 10: Bwindi to Lake Mburo, Uganda

Journey to Lake Mburo National Park. Enjoy an afternoon boat cruise on the lake. *Mihingo Lodge or similar*

Day 11: Lake Mburo to Entebbe, Uganda

Return to Entebbe via the Equator, with an opportunity for a photo taken on the equator (time permitting) and a last visit to some curios. Tour ends.
