### Days 1 - 2: Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe

Arrival in Victoria Falls and transfer to your lodge. With a variety of optional activities. Enjoy a sunset journey along the Zambezi River. *Ilala Lodge or similar*

### Days 3 - 4: Lake Kariba, Zimbabwe

Lake Kariba is Africa's largest man-made lake; explore the lake by partaking in an optional activity such as catch and release fishing. A sunset cruise is part of the itinerary. *River Lodge or similar*

### Day 5: Hwange National Park, Zimbabwe

Explore the northern part of Hwange National Park a remote and wildlife dense corner of Zimbabwe's largest national park. *Nantwich or similar*

### Day 6: Hwange National Park, Zimbabwe

Full-day game drive in Hwange National Park. *Nantwich or similar*

### Day 7: Hwange National Park, Zimbabwe

Full-day game drive en route to your lodge situated in the southern part of Hwange National Park. *Sable Sands or similar*

### Day 8: Hwange National Park, Zimbabwe

Morning game viewing activity with the afternoon at leisure to choose from optional activities. *Sable Sands or similar*

### Days 9 - 10: Matopos, Zimbabwe

Explore Matopos National Park by tracking rhino on foot, visiting Cecil John Rhodes'

Grave with its magnificent "World's View", and game drives. *Camp Amalinda or similar*

### Day 11: Great Zimbabwe Ruins, Zimbabwe

Discover the ancient ruins of Great Zimbabwe on an educational guided tour. *Lodge at the Ancient City or similar*

### Day 12: Harare, Zimbabwe

Harare is Zimbabwe's capital where you can experience a colonial style High Tea. Enjoy a sundowner cruise on a pontoon. *Bushman Rock Estate or similar*

### Day 13: Harare, Zimbabwe

Airport transfer after breakfast, tour ends.

### POST ADD-ON SAFARI

#### Day 13: Mana Pools, Zimbabwe

Board your charter flight from Harare to Mana Pools, a UNESCO World Heritage Site of pure wilderness. *Kanga Camp or similar*

#### Days 14 - 15: Mana Pools, Zimbabwe

Fill your days with wildlife focused activities such as guided safari walks and open vehicle game drives. The camp offers an "Armchair Safari" which is comfortable seats on a deck directly above a busy waterhole. *Kanga Camp or similar*

#### Day 16: Harare, Zimbabwe

Airport transfer after breakfast, tour ends.
